Our desire in returning to Romania was to encourage and equip local Christians to share the gospel of Jesus with the children of Romania. As you know, this hasn't always looked like we thought it would. But we are very excited to share that we were approached by AMEC (Child Evangelism Fellowship) to partner with them in their ministry of evangelism, training and resourcing children's workers. Over the past five years we have collaborated with AMEC, assisting and attending evangelistic events, camps, conferences and trainings. We have had initial conversations with the national director and manager and they are currently working on a contract so expectations are clear. We believe they are a good fit for our ethos, considering their focus on being faithful to the Scriptures. We have also started working on some concrete plans with the local AMEC workers (Ionuţ and Madalina Mateescu) regarding initiating on-field involvement. We are not leaving ECM, but rather starting an on-field partnership with AMEC. Please pray with us that this partnership will be mutually beneficial and encouraging and we would see the planting of seeds, growth and harvesting of fruit for the Kingdom. Stay tuned for more...

In our previous prayer letter, we shared the financial need of a loan to be able to keep working on our house in a timely manner to enable our family to move into our new home. God listened to our prayers and responded through a couple who have offered us an interest free loan that we believe will be enough to get the house to a state we can move into. We are so thankful for God's provision through this generous couple who understands our circumstances and are in position to help practically. We are very excited and we are trusting that we may be able to move in by the end of this year (or earlier). Adi and a close friend (who recently found himself unemployed), have continued to work on the house two days a week. Adi is currently looking for a team to install the pipes for the underfloor heating. Please pray that God would guide us to honest and competent tradesmen for the next stages and praise God with us for his ongoing and faithful provision.

Scholastic support

Whilst we are immensely thankful for the education that Anna and Luca are receiving through Primii Pasi (First Steps), considering the academic and behavioural challenges that they have both experienced, extra support, guidance and advice is always welcome. We were advised to contact Share Education Services and to attend their annual conference at the end of February in Siofok, Hungary. The Share Education conference focuses on children's education for families who are living and serving cross-culturally. We will be able to attend seminars and also consult individually with educators and counsellors. They also provide development and academic assessments, which Anna and Luca will be having. There will also be programs for the kids with the intention of building relational and academic skills. Whilst we didn't anticipate for this to be a part of our calendar, we are thankful that we can attend and pray that it will be valuable for our family.

We thank the Lord for your ongoing partnership in the gospel and pray that Lord would strengthen and sustain each one of us for his service and glory, wherever he has placed us and whatever season we find ourselves in. "Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." (1 Thes 5:16-18)
